



## LAMINATE WARRANTY/CARE & MAINTENANCE INFORMATION

Please Read Carefully

### LIMITED WARRANTY

Your laminated countertop is warranted for a period of one full year from date of purchase. This warranty covers defects or flaws in the workmanship and/or materials of the countertop. To obtain warranty performance, simply return the defective top to the original place of purchase. Upon notification by the seller, Selective Countertops will pick up and return the countertop to our plant where, after verification of the defect, will either repair or replace, at our option, the defective piece and return it to the original place of purchase. There will be no charge to you, the consumer, for shipping and handling or for the warranty work itself. It is important for you to **carefully inspect** your new countertops **before any installation** is started. **LABOR COSTS AND/OR MONETARY CONSIDERATION OF ANY KIND ARE NOT COVERED UNDER THIS WARRANTY.** This warranty does not cover damage resulting from customer storage, transportation, or installation. The warranty does not cover damage of the particle board due to exposure to a liquid. Nor, does it cover damage to the laminate caused by harsh chemicals or extreme heat (temperatures in excess of 275 degrees).

### Care & Maintenance

- **Miters & Joints:** When assembling, waterproof or water resistant glue should be used liberally. Any liquid on seams should be wiped up immediately. Spline miters are provided in joints in our countertops. Please remember that splines are only an accessory to assist the installer in the lining up of miters. Proper gluing and final adjustments are still required.
- **Removal of Labels:** Most labels can easily be removed by soaking with common household vegetable oil for a few hours. For stubborn labels, use a solvent such as lacquer thinner or acetone. **DO NOT USE RAZOR BLADES, KNIVES, SCOURING PADS, OR CLEANERS** as they will damage the finish of the laminate.
- **Heat:** Protect surface from hot items such as frying pans, griddles or ovenware as excessive heat (above 275°) will bubble the laminate. **DO NOT SET HOT ITEMS DIRECTLY ON COUNTERTOP.** Use hot pads or ceramic pot holders. Caution should also be taken when using countertop appliances (such as electric crock pots) that could transmit heat from their bottom heating coils.
- **Cleaning:** Clean with mild soap or detergent and warm water. **DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF SCOURING PAD OR SCOURING POWDER** as they will damage the finish of the laminate.

### ATTENTION INSTALLERS:

**CAREFULLY INSPECT ALL PIECES OF THE COUNTERTOP FOR FLAWS, COLOR MATCH, SIZE, AND FIT BEFORE INSTALLATION IS STARTED. LABOR COSTS ARE NOT COVERED BY THE LIMITED WARRANTY AND WILL NOT BE PAID BY THE SELLING DEALER OR SELECTIVE COUNTERTOPS, LLC.**



## LAMINATE TOPS WITH KARRAN UNDERMOUNTED SINK

Please Read Carefully

### LIMITED WARRANTY

The application of your undermount sink to your laminate top is warranted for a period of five (5) years from date of purchase. This warranty is limited to the bond between the sink and the countertop and does not supersede individual countertop and sink manufacturer's warranties.

Selective Countertops warrants that the bond between the sink and the laminate countertop will be free of flaws and defects and is waterproof.

To obtain warranty performance, contact Selective Countertops. Upon notification, Selective Countertops will make arrangements to inspect the countertop, if necessary and either repair or replace, at our option.

It is important for you to **carefully inspect** your new countertops **before any installation** is started. **LABOR COSTS AND/OR MONETARY CONSIDERATION OF ANY KIND ARE NOT COVERED UNDER THIS WARRANTY.** This warranty does not cover damage resulting from customer storage, transportation (see carrying instructions), or installation. The warranty does not cover damage to the particle board (substrate) due to exposure to liquid. Nor does it cover damage to the laminate by harsh chemicals or extreme heat (temperatures in excess of 275 degrees). The warranty does not cover wearing or chipping of laminate.
